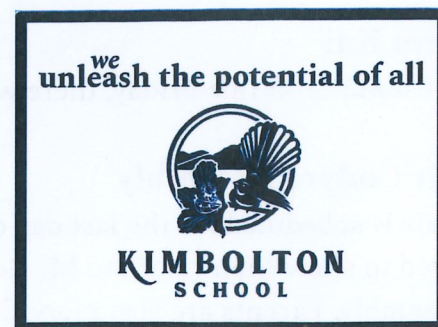


KIMBOLTON SCHOOL
